Virtual Senior Brunch

• In the era of COVID, we cannot conduct an in person Senior Brunch on Saturday, May 30th at 10:00am so we are moving it virtually – save the date! Families and their senior will receive special instructions to login to this formal Zoom meeting the week of May 25th. At 10:00am on 5/30, the class will hear keynote speeches from Matt Horvat and Gerald Buhaly honoring the journey of the Class of 2020. Then families/students will be ushered into specific "Homeroom Meeting Rooms". There, each Homeroom Advisor will read aloud their senior speech and give a toast to their Homeroom. At the end of the speeches the Homeroom can banter back and forth and then do a few toasts before they hop off the Zoom meeting. All meetings will be recorded and a mash up will be created to be sent out to families thereafter, that way families can review speeches made about their child and their children's friends in different Homerooms.



Mobile Graduation Processional

- In the era of COVID, we will not be able to hold Graduation on Sunday, June 7th. We will be postponing an in-person Graduation to later in the summer. To honor the significance of this day, we will conduct an optional "Mobile Graduation Processional".
- Final details will be sent to families and the community in May.

Logistics:

- We will stage graduates in their cars in the Junior Lot at 3:15pm. Graduates will be encouraged to wear their Cap & Gown and decorate their cars with "Class of 2020" messages. Graduates can either drive themselves of have one of their parents drive them.
- o Graduates with autoimmune compromised conditions are recommended to keep their windows up during the processional.
- At 4:00pm, the ASB President will lead the processional to the Upper Lot. On the way, they will see Faculty & Staff cars lined up (6 ft away from each other of course).
- Faculty/Staff will be in their cars, sit on their cars and/or be beside their cars and wave (whatever fits their comfort level). They will be encouraged to make signs.
- As the student's circle Fulton, they will see a "Senior Banner" with each of their names highlighted on it. Matt, Gerald, Meghan, Mike, and Senior Advisors will be standing by the banner and waving. Matt will be handing out a special gift to each senior.
- The processional will then continue down to some of the classes most memorable locations in Redmond where they will find visitors along the way.
