As the coronavirus outbreak continues to impact our region, our administration team, along with members of our risk management committee have been meeting each morning to discuss the best way forward in this uncertain time. Today, we decided to extend the learning opportunity for our faculty this Friday morning, so they can receive additional training on online tools and platforms to assist them in the advent of a prolonged school closure.

The training has been extended so that our class schedule for Friday has shifted to a late start schedule. **Students should arrive on campus Friday ready for class beginning at 9:30am.**
