**Student Services Account**

The Student Services Account consists of all non-tuition student related charges except for student transportation and project week travel. An account is established for each student. A minimum initial deposit is suggested for each student depending upon grade.

Some fees are included in the tuition, such as student accident insurance. However, use of many other student services will incur fees. Your student will incur some fixed fees, such as Associated Student Body (ASB) fees and fees that depend upon elective choices, such as lunch charges. Lunch charges, naturally, vary by appetite! Other fees charged to the student services account may include student supply purchases, lab fees, field trips, publications, class dues, some athletic clothing, gym equipment and elective activity charges, such as Ski Bus. Parents receive monthly balance statements during the school year, and can access detailed itemization online.

Although your student fee will vary by student, you are encouraged to deposit the minimum suggested deposit amounts listed below:

Suggested Minimum Initial Deposit Grades 5 – 8	\$ 750
Suggested Minimum Initial Deposit Grades 9 – 11	\$1,000
Suggested Minimum Initial Deposit Grade 12	\$1,500

**Project Week** (Depending Upon Choice of Project) \$0.00 to \$4,000

Most project week charges will be billed to the student account in connection with registration. Travel trips will be charged to the tuition account.

**Transportation Services** \$1,950 for a full-year pass\*\*

The full-year pass is for all-day service on one of the bus routes. Smaller passes, broken down by time of day and/or sports season, are also available.

\*\* Listed rate is for the 2017-18 school year and is subject to change. 2018-19 rates and routes will be set in August 2018.
