We are sincerely grateful for all that you have done to help create this extraordinary school. Thank you so very much.

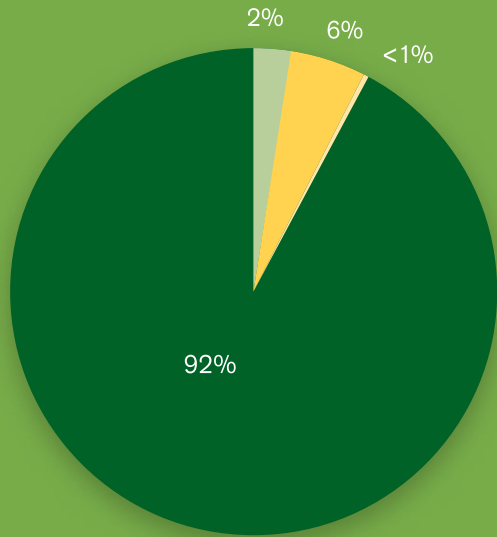

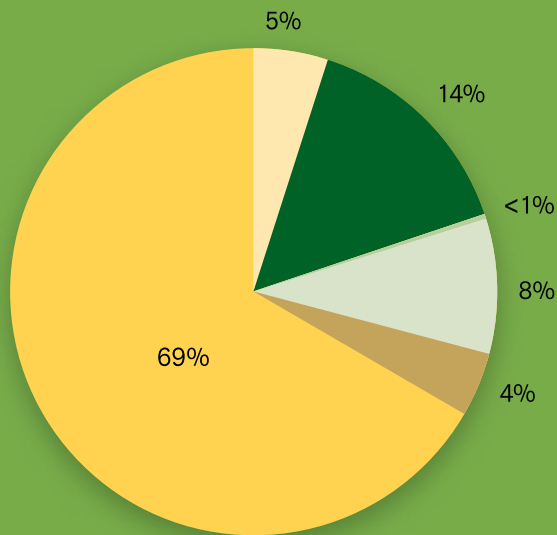

The Overlake Fund at Work

The 2017–18 Overlake Fund raised more than \$1 million in gifts and pledges for the first time in the school's history, thanks to the incredible outpouring of support from our community. Each and every donation supports our wonderful faculty, staff, and students, and strengthens all our academic and co-curricular programs. Additionally, the Overlake Fund is critical to providing 5% of the school's operating budget. We are pleased to share with you a few of the many ways this year's Overlake Fund made a visible difference in furthering our mission each and every day, especially meaningful during our 50th anniversary.

Inspire Excellence

Overlake faculty continue to inspire and challenge students to reach their potential both inside and outside the classroom. This year the school formally created the Experiential Education Department, headed by longtime faculty and Director of Outdoor Education Kent Renno, which now combines Outdoor Education, Service Learning, and Project Week as a unified academic department, with a mission to explore the unknown, learn by doing, lead by example, and cultivate lifelong learning.

For the first time ever, the AP Government class won a bid to compete in the national We The People Competition in Washington DC. Students demonstrated their knowledge of government and the Constitution by participating in simulated congressional hearings and was an invaluable opportunity to develop as civically engaged, responsible citizens—qualities that will stay with them throughout their lives.

Athletics had another banner year! Girls soccer and volleyball qualified for state, as did boys cross country. Girls volleyball and boys baseball also won the Emerald City League Championships. Girls tennis won both doubles and team State Championships.





And boys soccer defended their State Championship title for the second year in a row, while also maintaining the highest GPA of the 65 boys soccer teams in their division to clinch the Academic State Championship. Go Owls!

The music and theater departments also received standing ovations for their incredible productions, including the reprisal of the school's first-ever All-School Musical, *The Music Man*, in honor of our 50th anniversary. The jazz band participated in Clackamas College's Jazz Festival and brought back the first-place trophy to Overlake. Bravo!

A special congratulations to our Junior State of America club, which helps high school students acquire leadership skills and the knowledge necessary to be effective debaters and civic participants, for receiving the Pacific Northwest Chapter of the Year award, reflecting the high quality of our student speakers and their active engagement.

Develop Intellectual Curiosity

Overlake believes in the importance of investing in our faculty, the school's most important resource, through professional development. From presenting at conferences, learning about the latest developments in their disciplines, pursuing advanced degrees, and understanding new ideas, teachers improve their pedagogy and benefit the classroom experience for all students. A few examples this year included workshops and conferences for robotics, art education, flipped learning, technology, reading and teaching complex texts, wilderness first aid, and more.

Overlake is committed to encouraging curiosity in our students throughout our academic and co-curricular programs. This year, we hosted a grand total of 40 clubs. The Science Club also launched an innovative STEM symposium entitled *Innovations and Breaking Barriers* that hosted speakers whose expertise ranged from artificial intelligence to vascular surgery.

For the 50th anniversary, the Writer's Symposium featured three amazing alums, Eva Anderson '98, Nadia Petschek Rawls '03, and Brett Rawson '03, who all work in various writing and content development fields. They spent time with Upper School students during the day giving writing workshops, then presenting to the entire community in the evening. Middle School students were treated to Kazu Kibuishi,



author of the acclaimed graphic novel series, *Amulet*, for their Writer's Symposium. He spent two days on campus, gave a talk to the entire Middle School, and spent extended time with the seventh-grade English class.

The Library continued to expand its resources for students, both in print and online. Overlake is now one of the few independent schools in the country to give students access to Sora, a powerful digital reading platform. In partnership with the eleventh-grade AP non-fiction class, the Library helped students use Statistica for their research, the same software that colleges and businesses use for analytics.

Teach Responsibility and Foster a Compassionate Community

Our Middle and Upper School service days encapsulated over 2,000 hours of volunteer service! Service learning has been at the heart of Overlake since our beginning, and we continue to instill in our students the importance of stewardship and giving back to the community. Other examples of service learning throughout the school year included helping young children learn to read at a local school, providing meals and clothing to families at Avondale Park Transitional Housing, volunteering at hospitals and food banks, and much more.

Social Emotional Learning was brought to the forefront and woven into expanded Parliament, Study Hall, and Advisory time throughout the school year, and a new Owls Nest program connected students from both Upper School and Middle School for mentoring and community building. In doing this important work and learning about themselves, students are able to develop greater empathy, maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions.

For the 50th anniversary, the entire school went to the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation Discovery Center to experience the exhibition *Women Hold Up Half the Sky*, inspired by the book *Half the Sky: Turning Oppression into Opportunity for Women Worldwide*. Both the exhibition and the book featured Overlake and our sister school in Pailin, Cambodia. It was a powerful and inspiring reminder that students can come together to make lasting and positive change in the world.

Embrace Diversity

The eighth-grade Field Studies capstone program helps develop empathy, compassion, and understanding of differences. This year, students' 30-day projects ranged from fetching water from a creek to use as the sole source of drinking water, relying on crutches for mobility, sleeping in a tent, eliminating trash and plastics, exploring various religions, refugee issues, and homelessness, and much more.

A number of alumni and speakers came to campus to share their different backgrounds and experiences overseas, broadening our students' world views. CIA operative Brooke Marriott '04 delved into the role of the US in the global sphere and our influence in world politics, in connection with the eleventh-grade history class. Atsushi Kiuchi shared his personal experience as a Japanese American during and after WWII. We were also fortunate to have Jon Nordin '00 speak about his time as a soldier and veteran post September 11.

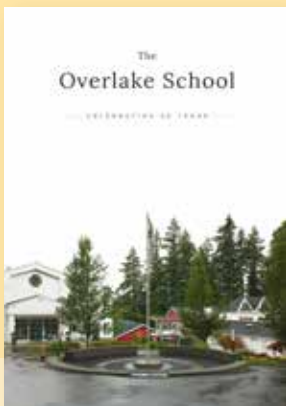
