One song (for example) has 33 tracks. The same student composed a second song with 50-some tracks. They are eager to play their songs for me from devices. I am stunned and caught off guard: so much variety in their compositions, so many layers of sound and feeling, and attention to details.

I hear the ukulele balanced with electronic keyboard and various moods, rhythms, tones. Upbeat, downbeat - the production, manipulation, and creation of sound. These students are in it and with it. Amazing what they've done in a short time.
